<p>Coming from tiny yields and aged all in French oak, the 2013 Bandol Rouge (90% Mourvèdre and 10% Grenache) has outstanding potential, although I doubt it will be for the instant gratification crowd. Offering lots of oak in its dark berry fruits, red currants licorice and spice-laced bouquet, this beauty is medium-bodied, polished and elegant, with present, yet ripe tannin. It will need 3-4 years of cellaring to integrate its oak, yet should have 15+ years of longevity.</p> <p>I was incredibly impressed by these latest releases from Guillaume Tari.
